30 שנה של אמנות בארץ

LA Art Show קיים את יריד האמנות השנתי שלו במרכז הכנסים בלוס אנג'לס בהשתתפות אלפי מבקרים שנהנו מחמישה ימי אמנות מרשימים של אמנים מכל רחבי העולם



90 גלריות השתתפו ביריד האמנות השנה

ארנון "Building Bridges Art Exchange" בלוס אנג'לס, המוקדש להקניית הבנה תרבותית דרך האומנות, הציג יצירות אמנות מאומנים שאיבדו את בתיהם וסטודיוותיהם בשריפות, כאשר כל ההכנסות יועברו לתמוך בה אורחים בתערוכה התקבלו על ידי פסל הדוב המרשים בגובה 30 רגל של ויקטור פרזו, ששימש כסמל כוח והתמדה עוצמתי. התערוכה כוללת סגנונות שונים מצוירים ועד פסלים, מה שהופך את החוויה כולה למרתקת. התלהבנו במיוחד לגלות בה ליטוגרפיות של האמנים האוסטרלים גוסטב קליסט ובן טיפוואי אנון שילה, בין הציירים המשפיעים ביותר בסאה ה-20.

תחת האוצרת מריסה קאציצ'ולו, הפלטפורמה הלא מסחרית של התערוכה, OIVERSEartLA, הציגה רטרוספקטיבה מרתקת בת שמונה שנים, עם כל יצירה הסמלית אבן דרך חשובה שמאתגרת את הסטטוס קוו, תוך הדגשת החשיבות של גיוון ושיוויון בתוך האומנות. התקנה האינטראקטיבית של האמן אנטואן רודריגו "שמאל" או "ימין" הציגה שקי אגרוף, המייצגים מנהיגים עולמיים ודיקטטורים, ואיפשרה למבקרים להפנות את תסכוליהם, ישירות אל פני ראשי המדינות שתמונתיהם הוצגו על השקים. בניהם, יכולתם למצוא את דונאלד טראמפ, ולדימיר פוטין ומחמוד אחמיניג'אד.

ברני טופין המוכר לכך יותר כפרזומואי וכותב שיריו של אלטון ג'ון, הוא גם אמן מוכשר. הוא הציג את יצירתו - Sleeping Beauty - Ragged Glory The Wall, קיר שלם של דגלי ארה"ב עם חבליים המתוחים על פניהם.

הצמד האמנותי הארגנטינאי, צ'יאצ'י וביאננה (MOLAA), הציגו את "חוגנים את הגיוון", דגל נאוה ארוג באורך 120 רגל שהוצג בעבר על ידי יותר מ-100 מתנדבים במהלך מצעד הטאוה של לונג ביץ'.

"המשימה שלנו ברורה: לקדם את האומנים והגלריות שמרכיבות את הנוף התרבותי שלנו", אמרה הספיקה והמנחה קסנדרה וויאג'יס. "ההחלטה התקבלה מתוך מחויבות חזקה לסייע בתהליכי הריפוי והשיקום תוך כדי מתן תמיכה קהילתית והפסקה טאוד נחוצה."

התערוכה הבאה שתוכננת להתקיים בין ה-11-7 בינואר 2026 במרכז הכנסים של לוס אנג'לס.

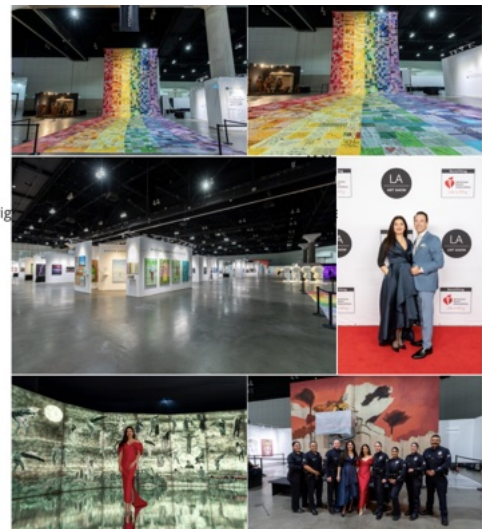

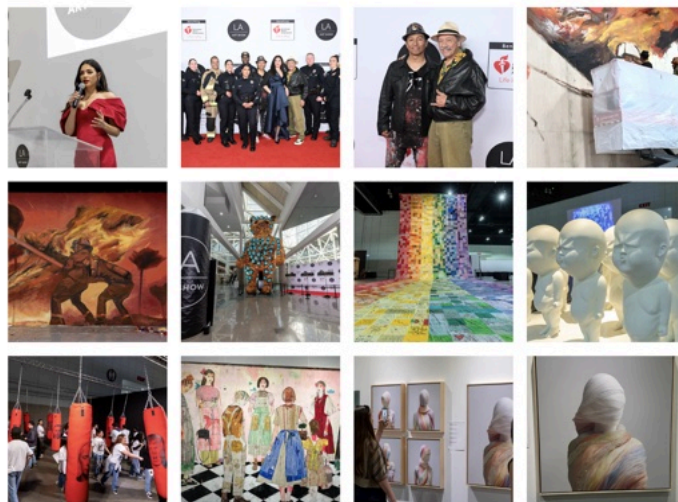

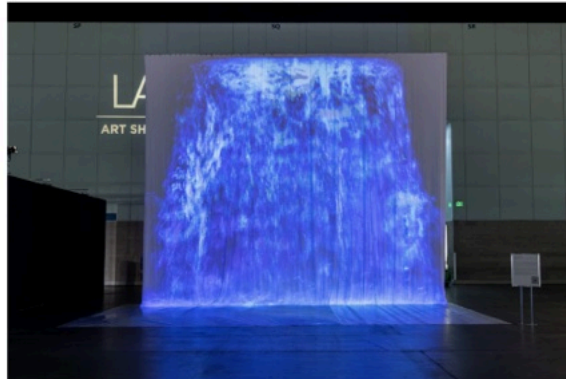

Each showcased piece pushed boundaries, advocating for inclusivity and diversity in the arts. Among the most engaging installations was Antuan Rodriguez's "Left" or "Right," which invited attendees to vent frustrations through punching bags adorned with images of global political figures. Meanwhile, Argentinian duo Chiachio & Giannone (MOLAA) exhibited their expansive 120-foot-long textile Pride flag, previously carried through the Long Beach Pride Parade, as a symbol of unity and celebration.

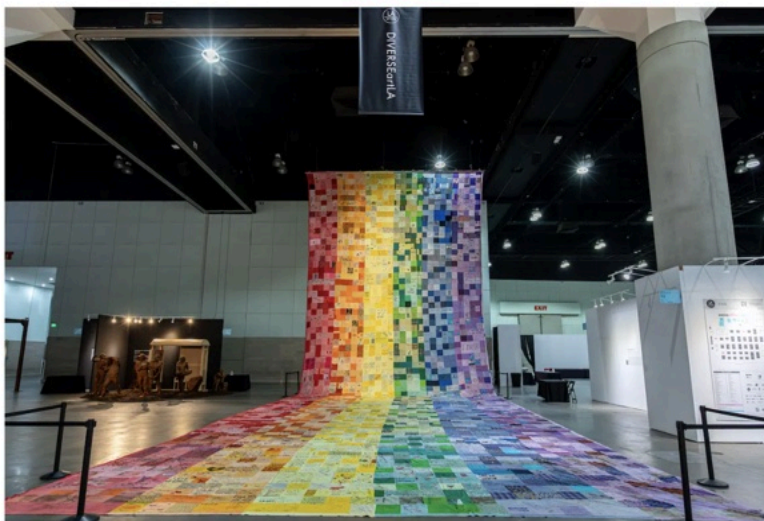

Gallery Dana Bay unveiled *The Wall*, a mixed-media mural by Bernie Taupin CBE that reimagines the American flag and its legacy. Felix Art Fair: Chaos & Beauty

Felix Art Fair is one of several fairs occurring simultaneously this year in the newly dubbed "LA Art Week." California is at higher risk for major earthquakes than previously known

By Clare Fonstein

An updated U.S. earthquake model showed slightly greater shaking possible in California than previously mapped.

The National Seismic Hazard Model, developed by the United States Geological Survey, says that most of California has at least a 75% chance of damaging earthquake shaking in the next 100 years — with at least a 95% chance for the Bay Area.

"Across California, the hazard has increased a little. It's not an alarming level of increase but it's something that helps us to understand more of the details of where shaking will be higher," said Mark Petersen, USGS geophysicist and lead author of the study.

The study measured the probability of experiencing a damaging earthquake taking into account magnitude, distance from the epicenter and likelihood of an earthquake, according to USGS research geophysicist Kevin Milner.

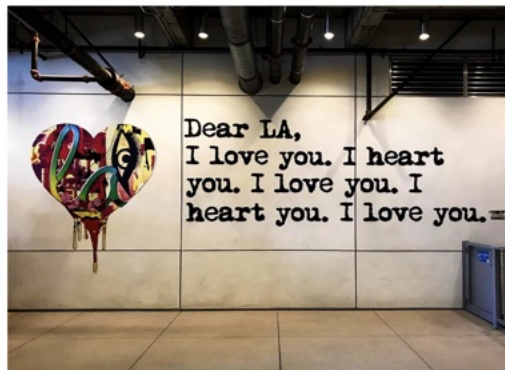

Mention the month of February and most people think of Valentine's Day or possibly Presidents' Day but, for art lovers, the month marks art week in Los Angeles. In February, two important exhibitions are again celebrating art and artists from local, national and international galleries: the sixth iteration of Frieze Los Angeles and the 30th edition of the LA Art Show. In addition, attendees of the seventh Felix Art Fair will again converge on the Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel and an upstart art fair in an abandoned post office is joining the scene.

Vibrancy of Los Angeles at Frieze
Frieze Los Angeles 2025 showcases the important contributions of Los Angeles to the art world. Christine Messemio, director

of Americas at Frieze, states, "As a major art center, Los Angeles plays an influential role in the global art scene. This year we will bring together a stellar roster of galleries and artists that reflect the vibrancy and diversity of Los Angeles and beyond."

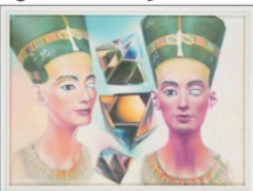
